SUMMARY CLEARANCE RATE REPORT FOR SMALL CLAIMS COURTS AT THE KANO

STATE JUDICIARY

Computing a clearance rate requires a calculation of the total number of cases and total number of cases disposed of through the delivery of judgments during a given

time, for example yearly or quarterly.

A high clearance rate indicates a higher disposal rate of cases.

1. Incoming Cases

Incoming cases as shown in the table and pictogram below represents cases being

carried forward from the previous year.

2. Total Number of New Cases

Total number of new cases as shown in the table and pictogram below represents

total number of new cases filed during the year under review.

3. Outgoing Cases

Outgoing cases as shown in the table and pictogram below represents cases

disposed of through the delivery of judgments during the year under review.

4. Total Number of Cases

Total number of cases as shown in the pictogram below represents total number of cases; comprised of cases brought forward from the previous year (if applicable)

and new cases filed during the year under review.

5. Clearance Rate

The clearance rate is calculated as: **Disposed Cases** X 100%

Incoming Cases and Outgoing Cases represent all liquidated debt commercial disputes within the monetary threshold of N5 Million naira and below, presided over by the designated small claims courts by virtue of Article 2 (1) (d) of the

Magistrate Court Law Practice Direction on Small Claims 2018.


