**JUDGMENT**

This matter was instituted by the Claimant on the 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 when the complaint was filed before this honourable court.

The claimant claims against the Defendants the sum of N1,550,000 in respect of money converted by the Defendants from the Claimants Company money realized from the sale of the company's goods.

An order to serve the 3<sup>rd</sup> defendant through substituted means was granted and the Defendant was served through substituted means by pasting the court processes and the order of the court in a conspicuous position at the court house premises.

The defendant was therefore served through substituted means on the 2<sup>nd</sup> December, 2021.

On the 24<sup>th</sup> of January, 2022 the matter was mentioned and the Plaintiff's counsel applied for judgment to be entered as the Defendants are yet to file a defence before the court.

As such, upon the provision of Article 6 (3) of the Magistrate Court Practice Directions on Small Claims 2018 of Kano State, which is to the effect that where the Defendant fails to file an answer to the claim such defendant may be held to have admitted the claim.

Judgment is hereby entered in favour of the Plaintiff one Hassan Plastic Industries Ltd against the three (3) Defendants one Shidu

Sylvanus Shidu, Jerry K. Ejinu and Aremu Stephen Bamidele in the sum of N1,550,000 as per the Plaintiff's claim.

Similarly, the Defendants are to pay a filing fee of N11,000 to the Plaintiff.
